- DashaPhal (Results of Planetary Periods) Mahadasha and Antardasha




- Gathered Birth Charts (D1) of Selected Individuals:

5. Astrological Analysis


- Planetary Connections:

- Studied the outcomes of planetary periods to discern correlations between specific periods and career hurdles.


